We are located 21 km (13 miles) south of the TransCanada

☐ From the East (Calgary), the turn-off onto Shuswap

~ Chase Creek Road is 2 km past the Petro-Can at

Chase.

☐ From the West (Vancouver) turn 2 km after the

Esso with the big wooden bear. (Onto Shuswap ~

Chase Creek Road ~ not Harper Lake Road!).

☐ If you are travelling from the Okanagan through

Falkland, turn right up Chase ~ Falkland Road across

from the Falkland Pub and take the first driveway

on your left after you have gone 21 km (13 miles).

Coaches Bio's:

Marc is an experienced event rider who has competed through the Advanced level and ridden several horses through the CCI**. He is a graduate A pony clubber and an ICP level 3 certified instructor. He is licensed to design cross country courses through Preliminary level.

She began riding at the tender age of seven and after years and years of persistence her Dad bought her a pony two years later. Maeve's early years of riding began with 4H, which then lead to her passion of 3-Day Eventing.
