

# **COMPETITOR INFORMATION - 2018**

## **Equestrian Canada – Requirements**

Competitors must hold a valid EC Sport License – Eventing at the applicable level. The level of license required is dependent on the division in which the rider/horse is competing

#### DAY TICKET

An Eventing Day Ticket is available for those who wish to try the sport at Entry Level or below Horse Trial or in an Eventing Test . A Day Ticket may be purchased at the competition and is only valid for the duration of the event.

# PERMISSION TO COMPETE IN EVENTS IN THE USA

Canadians, who plan to compete at eventing competitions in the USA in 2018 must:

- 1. Be a current member in good standing of Equestrian Canada.
- 2. Must hold a current Equestrian Canada Sport License Eventing at the applicable level.
- 3. Must be member of the USEA in order to compete at USEA recognized competitions.
- 4. Horses must be registered with the USEA with a Full or Limited registration status to compete at novice or above levels.
- 5. Must meet minimum eligibility requirements criteria and regulations of the USAE/USA Equestrian (if competing in nationally sanctioned competitions ie HTs )
